Joseph Edward GRAYSON was a drummer boy with the Royal Field Artillery. He died in the Castle Red Cross Hospital, Ryde, in March 1919. He was originally from Leeds and his mother came to visit him a week before his death. He was 15 years old. He was buried with full military honours.
