

HAYWARD GROUP



Stanley HAYWARD was a driver, aged 20, of Yeovil, Somerset. He died from wounds at Hazelwood Red Cross Hospital, Ryde, on 10 April 1915. The words on the badge of the Royal Artillery read 'UBIQUE QUO FAS ET GLORIA DUCUNT' and translates as 'EVERYWHERE WHERE RIGHT AND GLORY LEAD'
