Mrs. E. M. JOLLIFFE.- Mrs. **Ethel May JOLLIFFE**, aged 91, died at her home, St. Leonards, Binstead Road, Binstead, on Sunday. She was the eldest daughter of the late Mr. J. H. VENUS. Her husband, Mr. Horace Percy JOLLIFFE, was killed in action in 1916 on the Western Front. Mrs. JOLLIFFE took a lifelong interest in the Church of the Holy Cross, and for many years served on the Parochial Council. She was also an active member of the former Binstead women's section of the Royal British Legion, and for some years was standard bearer. She was a member of Binstead branch of the IW Conservative Association. A brother and two sisters survive her. The funeral took place yesterday at the Church of the Holy Cross and she was interred at Binstead Cemetery.
