Retired Builder Dies. - Mr. Frederick Harry ADAMS, a life-long resident of Ryde, died on Monday at 10 Mount Street, the home of his son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. C. F. FISHER. A retired master builder, he succeeded to the business started in the town by his grandfather more than a century ago and continued by his father. During the 1914-18 war he served in the Royal Engineers. He was a lifelong Methodist and an active member of the Garfield Road church. He was a member of Ryde branch of Toc H, and also took a keen interest in the welfare of animals. A widower, he leaves three daughters. The funeral at Garfield Road Methodist Church on Thursday was followed by burial at Ryde Cemetery.
