Mr. A. A. ANDERSON.- For many years a chorister at St. John's Church, Mr. **Arthur Albert ANDERSON**, of 87 Great Preston Road, died on Friday. He was 88 and leaves two sons and four daughters, his wife having died 10 years ago. Mr. ANDERSON was a retired foreman platelayer on the railways. He came to Ryde in 1918 from Surrey and was a founder-member of the old St. John's Working Men's' Club.
