**DEATH OF MR. G.H. REEVES**

The town has lost a highly esteemed resident in the death at his home, Ingledene, Bellevue Road, Ryde, on Saturday, of Mr. **George Henry (Laurie) REEVES**, at the age of 68. A native of Ventnor, Mr. REEVES served in the South African War. Subsequently he went to Canada, and on the outbreak of the first world war immediately volunteered for active service, coming to Europe and serving in France until the fourth year of the conflict, when he was discharged after being badly gassed. In 1924 Mr. REEVES returned from Canada, and during the last war discharged police duties at Messrs. SAUNDERS-ROE, East Cowes. Sincere sympathy is felt with his widow in her irreparable loss.

The funeral took place yesterday (Wednesday), interment being at Binstead following a service at St. Marys's R.C. Church, Ryde.
