#### **OBITUARY MRS. E. R. GAWN**

The death occurred on Monday at the great age of 90 years of a much esteemed resident, Mrs. **Ellen Rose GAWN**. Mrs. GAWN's death actually took place on the 53rd anniversary of the death of her husband, who sacrificed his own life in saving two children from drowning in Scratchell's Bay in 1889, when he was first mate on the yacht Corinne.

Mrs GAWN had lived for 20 years with the family of Councillor H. V. TAYLOR at 45 Green-street, Ryde. In her early days' she was with the family of the late Sir John LEES at Beechlands, Dover-street. Retaining good site to the end she occupied much time in needlework to assist deserving causes.

The funeral takes place at All Saints' Church tomorrow (Friday) at 3 p.m.

#### **MRS. E. R. GAWN**

The funeral of Mrs. **E. R. GAWN**, who died at 45 Green-street, Ryde, took place on Friday. She was 90 years of age and had lived with her nephew, Councillor H. V. TAYLOR and his family for over 20 years.

The service was at All Saints' Church and was conducted by Rev. Canon R. S. MOXON, D.D., assisted by the Rev. F. H. ROLPH, A.K.C. "The Lord is My Shepherd" was chanted by the choir boys, and two hymns, "Rock of Ages" and "Jesu Lover of My Soul" were also sung at the expressed wish of the deceased.

The mourners were Mr. H. V. TAYLOR, Mrs. F. LAKE, Mrs. A. and W. TAYLOR, Mesdames H.V., and J. and S.V. TAYLOR, Mrs. E. TAYLOR, Mr. S. TAYLOR, Mr. F. LAKE, Mr. H. MARCH, Mrs. LAMBRICK, Mrs. MARSH, and Mrs. HAVELOCK. There were also a large number of friends at the church.

The interment was in the Ryde Cemetery in the same grave as her late husband who predeceased her on the same date exactly, September 7th, fifty-three years ago. He sacrificed his own life in saving the lives of two children from drowning. There were over 30 floral tributes.
