### **DEATH OF MR. J. S. SLINN**

Mr. John Stockdale SLINN, a gentleman of independent means, who had live in the town for 36 years died at his residence Warren Cottage, Belvedere Street, Ryde, on Thursday. Mr. SLINN, who was 85 years of age, had suffered an illness which had deprived him of speech for five or six years. Although not taking an active part in the public affairs of the town, Mr. SLINN was known to a wide circle of acquaintances. In his younger days he was a well known follower of hounds. He leaves one daughter, his wife having pre-deceased him 21 years ago.
