MR. OLIVER PERKIS DIES AT RYDE POPULAR LOCAL FIGURE

After a serious illness, fought with quiet determination and courage, one of Ryde's most popular figures, Mr. Oliver PERKIS, of 80 Well street, Ryde, died at his home on Friday. He was 74.

Mr. PERKIS was well-known as a master builder, which business he founded some 50 years ago. He was the youngest son of Mr. Samuel PERKIS, who was responsible for the designing of the stained-glass windows at Quarr Abbey and Binstead Wesleyan Church.

He had been president of Ryde Spiritualist Church for 40 years. His wife, Mrs. Daisie PERKIS, then founded the church and has been its secretary since. Before his retirement from his business two years ago Mr. PERKIS designed and built the vestry of the church.

There were no children of the marriage.
