A native of Ryde, and a deacon of Ryde Congregational Church, Mr. ATTRILL was padre to the Toc H. branch and to the Royal Ancient Order of Buffaloes. He was also Noble Grand and padre of the East Medina Lodge of Oddfellows. He served in the Royal Engineers in the First World War, and was ordained in 1917.

The funeral service will take place at Ryde Congregational Church at 2.45 p.m. today (Thursday) when the Minister, the Rev. Barnard SPAULL will officiate. Interment will follow in Ryde Cemetery.
