FUNERAL OF MRS ETCHELLS.- The funeral took place on Wednesday, 24th Oct. of Mrs **Ellen ETCHELLS**, wife of the Rev. James ETCHELLS the veteran retired Wesleyan minister, in her 87th year. Mrs ETCHELLS, who had been in failing health for 18 months, came to reside in the town about nine years ago on the retirement of her husband from the ministry. She resided at Clyde House, Dover Street. Nearly two years ago deceased and her husband celebrated the jubilee of their wedding.

The first part of the service was held at the Wesleyan Church. The Rev. W. SEED (superintendent minister), who officiated, was assisted by the Rev. A. PRIGGS and the Rev. E. P. PICKEN. Mr SEED spoke of deceased's unfailing kindness and hospitality. "Peace, perfect peace" and "There is a land of pure delight" were the hymns sung. As the coffin was taken from the church the organist (Mr E. P. TOPP) played the funeral march. The mourners were Rev. James ETCHELLS (husband), Mr Hutchings ETCHELLS, Swansea, and Mr C. D. ETCHELLS (sons), Mrs H. ETCHELLS and Mrs C. D. ETCHELLS (daughters-in-law).
