Girl's Sudden Death - The death occurred suddenly on Thursday of Miss Carol Dorothy Betty ATTRILL, aged 17, of 2 Whiteway Cottages, Asheys Road, who was one of a family of seven and the third daughter of Mr. and Mrs. W. A. J. ATTRILL. She had been employed by Mr P. G. RUSSELL at the Swanmore Inn, but had not been to work for three days on account of a cold. Early on Thursday morning she complained of feeling worse and lapsed into unconsciousness. She died while her father had gone to fetch a doctor.

After a post mortem examination the Coroner decided that an inquest was unnecessary. Miss ATTRILL was a former pupil of Green Street C. of E. School and a member of the W.R.A.C. (T.A.)
