DEATH OF MRS. J.E. MINTER.

It's with regret that we have to record the death at her daughter's house, 1 Argyle-street, on Friday week, of Mrs. **Jane Elizabeth MINTER**, at the advanced age of 84. Mrs. MINTER was the widow of Mr. John MINTER, who will be remembered as the proprietor of a butcher's business in High-street, where the Westminster Bank now stands. The late Mrs. MINTER was the only daughter of Mr. W.C. WOODS, one of the founders of Messrs. W. and J. WOODS'S business in Cross-street. She was greatly interested in the Seaman's Missions, and was probably the oldest living member of the Garfield-road Methodist Church. She leaves two daughters, Mrs. M. SMITH, of 1 Argyle-street, and Mrs. E.L. BLACKBURN, of 74 Pellhurst-road, with whom much sympathy is felt. The funeral was at the Cemetery on Monday and was conducted by the Rev. W. HUNT-FULLER (Methodist), the family being represented by the two grandsons, Mr. John MINTER and Mr. Dennis SMITH, Mr. A. BLACKBURN (son-in-law), Mr. D.O. HOGG, and Mr. H. COLYER.
