DEATH OF MR. J. G. DUFFETT

The funeral of a much respected and esteemed townsman, in the person of the late Mr. **J. G. DUFFETT**, for many years proprietor of the Lion Brewery in the High-street, took place amidst many signs of sympathy on Thursday at the Ryde Cemetery, the Rev. C. Rhodes HALL, B.D., officiating. There was a profusion of beautiful floral tributes, numbering over 30, from members of the family and brother townsmen. The body was enclosed in a shell and massive panelled oak coffin, with heavy brass fittings, the inscription on the breast-plate being: "James Garland DUFFETT, died January 17th, 1909, aged 66 years." The mourners present were Mr. J. G. DUFFETT, jun., Mr. H. DUFFETT, Mr. J. RASHLEY, Mr. F. G. FLUX, J.P., Mr. G. LAKE, Mr. W. SMITH, Mr. A. W. HILL, Mr. J. PRIOR, Mr. W. PRIOR, Mr. J. MACKMIN, Mr. W. MORRIS, Mr. H. MORRIS, Mr. EXTON, Mr. Edmund HORN, Mr. H. HUDSON, and Mr. Frank DUNFORD. There were also many friends at the Cemetery, including Ald. H. SWEETMAN, J.P., Councillor R. RUSSELL, Mr. John MINTER, Mr. C. LOCKE, Mr. G. LOCKE, Mr. F. W. MUNT, Mr. A. A. AUSTIN, Mr. J. PORTER, and many others. The funeral arrangements were carried out by Messrs. A. J. and W. COOMBES.
