**RYDE PIER RAILWAY WORKER DIES AGED 34.**

A popular member of the British Railways Ryde Pier staff, Mr. **Clarence JENNINGS**, 72 Broadway Cresent, Binstead Estate, died at St. Mary's Hospital, Newport, on Tuesday. He was 34. Mr. JENNINGS started work at Ryde Pier in September 1943, as a junior tram conductor. Four years later in January 1947, he joined the Army for his national service, returning to Ryde, St. John's Station with British Railways in 1949.

Mr. JENNINGS was promoted to porter-guard in 1951, and subsequently became a tram driver and ticket-collector.

Mr. JENNINGS leaves a wife and two sons, aged 4 and 10.

A service at All Saints Parish Church on Saturday will be followed by interment at Ryde Cemetery. Messrs. C. LANGDON of Ryde, are making the arrangements.
