RYDE MAN'S SUDDEN DEATH

His friends and relatives were shocked last Saturday to hear of the death of **William BUDDEN**, who lived in a flat on the Strand, Saturday morning at the early age of 29. Mr BUDDEN was employed at the Empire Meat Company and at about 7 o'clock in the morning suddenly collapsed and died, it is believed from heart failure and appendicitis. He was in the army at the close of the war and served with the Hampshire in Constantinople and elsewhere for about four years. He leaves a widow with whom much sympathy is felt in her sudden bereavement.
