DEATH OF MR. JOHN MINTER

After a long illness Mr. **John MINTER**, butcher, of High-street, died on Sunday. Deceased who was in his 67th year, was well known and highly respected in the town. He had been a member of the Board of Guardians, and at one time represented the parish of Ashley on the Rural District Council. He had also served as an overseer.
