COUNCILLOR BEREAVED

The death occurred at Brynmar, Dover Street, on Monday of **Mrs. Lydia BROWNSDON**, aged 90, mother of Mr. J.B.W. BROWNSDON, an East Ward representative on the Town Council. Mrs. BROWNSDON was the youngest of nine children of Mr. Isaac BARTON, Mayor of the town in 1889 and 1890. Her brother Mr. John I. BARTON was also a Mayor ---from 1913 until 1918. Mrs. BROWNSDON was the widow of Dr. H.W.B. BROWNSDON, They spent most of their life in Birmingham before returning to Ryde in 1948. The funeral service at the Parish Church on Thursday was conducted by the vicar (the Rev. R.H. GRANGER). The interment followed in the family grave. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. J.B.W. BROWNSDON and Mr. and Mrs. H.P.W. BROWNSDON, and Mr. and Mrs. R.C.W. BROWNSDON (sons and daughters-in-law), and Mr. and Mrs. J.F. BROWNSDON (grandchildren).
