RYDE PIER NIGHT WATCHMAN'S SUDDEN END –

Sincere regret will be felt in Ryde and in the Island generally at the death of Mr. **Arthur Frederick NEWBERY** (71), of 22 Prince-street, Ryde, who will be known to many as the cheery night-watchman on Ryde Pier. He was found dead in the early hours of Saturday morning by P.C. MAYBURY, in his office by the Pier Gates. Mr. NEWBERY joined the pier staff in 1887 as a tram driver, which position he held until about five years ago, when he took over the job of night watchman. His readiness to joke at any time during his lonely vigil endeared him to everybody who travelled by the late boats. He was an invalid for nearly six months last year, but returned to work feeling very well. He had been keenly interested in the Oddfellows' movement all his life.

Mr. NEWBERY leaves a widow and five children, two daughters and three sons. The funeral service was held at the Primitive Methodist Chapel, the Rev. C.FINLAY officiating. The interment took place at the Ryde Cemetery. Mrs. NEWBERY was unable to attend.
