OBITUARY MRS. S. GARDNER

The death occurred very suddenly at her home, 6, Prince Street, on Tuesday week, of Mrs. **Amy Morris GARDNER**, wife of Mr. Samuel GARDNER, a retired civil servant. Mrs GARDNER had just sat down after clearing the tea-table when she was suddenly taken ill and died shortly afterwards. Mr. and Mrs. GARDNER came to Ryde on Mr GARDNER's retirement four years ago from London to be near a relative, Mrs. A. BARKHAM, licensee of the Prince of Wales, High Street. They had lived at Haylands for the greater part of this period.

The funeral took place on Saturday at the Ryde Cemetery, the Rev. E. J. FORSE (All Saint's curate) officiating.
