We regret to record the death of Mr. **Isaac BARTON**, which occurred at his residence, Partlands Avenue on Monday morning. Until his retirement a few years ago, Mr. BARTON was one of the most active members of the Town Council, and his shrewd common sense made him a most valuable member. At the time of his retirement he was an Alderman and a J.P., of the Borough; in fact he was the senior Justice of the Peace since the death of Mr. Thos. DASHWOOD a few weeks since. Mr. BARTON occupied the position of Mayor of the Borough in 1889-90, and filled the position with ability. For many years he was the leading builder and contractor in the Island, and the substantial character of his work is evidenced by the many public buildings which he erected, the noble spire of the Parish Church being one of the many works he successfully carried out. Deceased was 73 years of age.
