- He retired from business in 1924 and moved to Ryde with his wife Bertha.



- They ran a boarding establishment at Crofton House, George Street, Ryde
- Joseph took great interest in the town's activities; he was a member of the Ratepayers' Association; district secretary of the County Hospital Contributory Scheme and he had a keen interest in the Ryde Bowling Club
- He regularly wrote about the bowling matches played at the Pavilion indoor green for the IW Times under the nome de plume "Indoor Scribe"
