DEATH OF MRS. NOBBS

Sympathy was felt with the relatives of Mrs. **Anne NOBBS**, aged 31, of 37 Adelaide Place, who died at her home on Sunday. Mrs NOBBS had been a patient at the Royal I.W. County Hospital since November and was allowed home at Easter to be with her husband and her 16-months-old daughter. She was a native of Todmorden, Lancashire, and during the war was a radio operator in the W.R.A.F. Her husband is cashier at Barclays Bank Sandown. The funeral took place at All Saint's Church on Thursday, the Rev. P.L. VAUGHAN officiating.

The mourners were Mr. R. NOBBS (husband), Mr. and Mrs. E.J. NEWELL (mother and father), Mrs. A.K. NOBBS (mother-in-law); Mr. S. WRIGHT (uncle), and Mesdames W.WILSON and W.
