**THE LATE MRS. L. NEWNHAM –**

The death occurred suddenly on Friday week, a few days after the wedding of her grand-daughter, formerly Miss J. PECK, of Mrs. **Lily NEWNHAM** aged 76, of 1 Mars Hill, Carlton-road. Mrs. NEWNHAM was born in London and came to the town as a young girl of about 18. Her husband, the late Mr. Walter NEWNHAM was a railway clerk before his death in 1918. Mrs. NEWNHAM was a member of the St. John's Women's Institute. She is survived by her only daughter, Mrs. G.W. PECK, and two grandchildren. The funeral took place on Wednesday, when a service at St. John's Parish Church was conducted by the Vicar (the Rev. A.J. PEARMAN). The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. G.W.
