DEATH OF LIEUT.-COL. DASHWOOD

We regret to announce the death of Lieut.-Col. **Frank DASHWOOD**, V.D., who passed away on Saturday at his residence, West Hill, West-street, at the age of 77. The funeral took place on Tuesday morning at St. James Church, the Rev. E. C. UNMACK, officiating. Among those present in the Church were Col. E. W. CRADOCK, the Mayor (Alderman John I. BARTON), Major ELLERY, Alderman H. SWEETMAN, Alderman G. E. MEARS, Messrs. Arthur ANDREWS, J. HANSFORD, John FARDELL, George FARDELL, B. GULLIVER, W. GRIFFIN, and J. ELDRIDGE. The mourners were Miss DASHWOOD (sister), Miss Bertha DASHWOOD, Master Guy WADDINGTON (great nephew) and Nurse BARR. The late Lieut.-Colonel DASHWOOD was one of the earliest members of the Volunteers, and rose from the ranks. A special memoir of the deceased officer will appear in our next issue.
