FOUND DROWNED

Yesterday (Friday) morning a young man named **William LANGFORD**, aged about 20, seaman belonging to H.M. troopship *Seraphis*, was found drowned in the water at the stern of the vessel transit lying near the George-street slipway. Deceased, whose mother lives at Haylands, and whose father was killed some years since in the sluice accident, had engaged to be taken to Portsmouth early in the morning in Mr. GAWN'S boat, but his body was found in the position indicated by Mr. D. REEVES. An inquest will be held to-day (Saturday).
