**OBITUARY**  
**Mr J.G. DUFFETT**

It is with very deep regret that we record the passing of Mr. **James George DUFFETT**, which took place on Wednesday at his residence, Beancote, Wood Street, Ryde. Mr. DUFFETT was 69 on Sunday, having been born on December 1, 1866. he had never really recovered from the shock of his second wife's death about three years ago, but only became seriously ill in August, since when he had been confined to his house.

Mr. DUFFETT had been a familiar figure in the business and social life of the town for many years, and his death will be widely mourned by the wide circle of friends whom he attracted by his genial personality. There was hardly a charitable cause in the town which had not benefited by his generosity. He was in the corn business at 6 High Street until 1909, when on the death of his father, Mr. James Garland DUFFETT, he took over the Lion Brewery. Retiring from business in 1921 he farmed Beancote for several years. It was while he was residing at Asheys that his daughter, Marie Dorothy, died. He returned to Beancote, Wood Street, Ryde, where he resided until his death. In his early years he was a member of the Yeomanry and for many years was associated with the Conservative cause, being a member of the Ryde Conservative Club. For many years he was hon treasurer of the Ryde Royal Regatta, and he filled a similar post

With the Haylands Horticultural Society, and until his illness this year he was never absent from the functions of these societies. He was also connected with the Ryde Carnival, Ryde Rowing Club and the Asheys Sports Club, and was also a member of the Ryde Club. He leaves one son. His first wife predeceased him in 1897.

The funeral will take place tomorrow at the Parish Church at 2.30.p.m. the interment following at Ryde Cemetery at 3.p.m.
