We greatly regret to announce that Mrs. **SUTTON**, of the Beeches, Asheys-road, has received official news, that her husband Pte. **Gurney Sinclair SUTTON**, Dorset Regiment, was killed in France on August 27th. The gallant young fellow who gained the respect and esteem of all who knew him, was the son of the late Mr. R. W. SUTTON, and of Mrs. SUTTON of Ventnor, and some four years ago married the only daughter of Lieut. Col. F.G. FLUX and Mrs. FLUX, of The Beeches, Ryde.

When he joined up he was in the Southampton branch of the Capitol and Counties Bank and was formerly in the Ryde branch. He leaves a little son aged 2.
