OBITUARY MR. W. SWEETMAN

The funeral of Mr. **Walter SWEETMAN**, of Woodlands, Queen's-road, Ryde, took place on Thursday, the Rev. F. H. ROLPH officiating. The first part of the service was at the Parish Church, and the interment in the Ryde Cemetery, where many beautiful flowers were placed.
