**FORMER RYDE HOTELIER'S DEATH
MISADVENTURE VERDICT AT SOUTHSEA INQUEST**

Her many friends heard with regret of the death following an eye operation at the Lonsdale Nursing Home, Southsea, at the weekend, of Mrs, **Nellie INMAN**, of the Seaford Hotel, St. Thomas's Street, Ryde. She was the widow of Mr. Cecil INMAN and came from London nearly 30 years ago and until her retirement had jointly conducted the Seaford, one of the best-known private hotels in the borough. Mrs. INMAN was much esteemed in the town and sympathy is felt with her son and daughter.

At the inquest at Portsmouth, on Tuesday, the Coroner (Mr. P.H. CHILDS) said that the evidence showed that the operation had been properly carried out and he recorded a verdict of death by misadventure.
