#### BUSINESSMAN'S DEATH –

Mr. **Percy James GUMBRELL**, aged 75, who had been in business as a confectioner in High-street for 40 years, died on Wednesday at his home, Pan Gardens, Queens-road. Born at Gosport, he was apprenticed at H.M. Dockyard, Portsmouth, before beginning an adventurous life serving in ships to many parts of the world. On one occasion he travelled far up the Amazon river, and, on another finding himself in Canada at the time of the formation of the Royal Canadian Navy, he became one of the first volunteers to enlist. In the last war he was employed by the War Department as a ship's surveyor. His principal interest lay in ships and the sea. He became a member of the Royal Yacht Club and often took out his small cabin cruiser and enjoyed fishing. As a young man he took an active interest in boxing. He was a member of the Ryde Club and the Town Club, and had played for both in snooker league matches. He was a member of the Vectensian Lodge of Freemasons. His wife died two and a half years ago, and he leaves three sons and two daughters. The funeral takes place at All Saints Parish Church on Monday at 2 p.m.
