\*Merlin\* – The English Schooner Yacht in the Solent off Cowes – Oil on board – 37 x 56 cm – Private Collection in Great Britain

\*Nimrod\* – The Irish Cutter (Royal Western Yacht Club) off the Needles – 40 x 61 cm – signed - Private Collection

\***Peronelle**\* 1873 – The English Life–Ship helping another vessel in a gale – 38 x 55 cm – signed, inscribed "Ryde" and dated

\*Serapis\* English troopship arriving at Portsmouth with the Price of Wales onboard, the Royal Yacht \*Osborne\* beyond 1876 – 86 x 149 cm – signed and dated – one of his main works - British Collection

\*Sydney\* Capt. Gunnerst 1871 – The Swedish Barque under sail passing the Eddystone Lighthouse – 51 x 76 cm – signed, inscribed "Ryde" and with title and dated - Private Collection in Great Britain

\*The Heroine\* – The English Racing Cutter of the Royal Yacht Squadron and other shipping off the Isle of Wight – 66 x 92 cm

\*Unidentified\* c. 1880 – Portrait of an English Topsail–Schooner under shortened sails at sea – 51 x 61 cm – not signed, well attributed to Fowles
