It is with deep regret that we report the death of Mr. **Thomas SIVELL** on Wednesday morning, after an illness patiently borne for eight years. He was for 20 years the partner of Mr. E. PALMER, the well-known carriage-builder in Ryde.

Mr. SIVELL was for a great number of years the organist at St. James' Church. Before that he was the organist at the United Methodist Church, and during the war performed the same service for the Primitive Methodist Church in High-street. In his younger days he was an enthusiastic member of the old Volunteer Band for some nine years. His wife predeceased him by four years and he leaves one son, a captain on the Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Coy.'s vessel "Bullmouth."
