THE LATE MR. **S.S.STONE** –

The death occurred at St Mary's Hospital, Newport, on Friday week, after a long illness, of Mr. **Spencer Stewart STONE**, aged 88, of Fuchsia Cottage, Steyne-road, Bembridge.
