SUB-POSTMASTER'S DEATH

A family association of nearly 70 years with the Monkton-street sub-post office, one of the earliest in the town, was ended by the death at a Wootton nursing home on Sunday of Mr. Eugene Vivian TICEHURST, aged 75, who was a sub-postmaster there for 25 years. After conducting a photographic business here and in Newport during which time he specialised in illustrations for yachting publications, he succeeded his father, the late Mr. H. A. TICEHURST, who opened the sub-office in 1882. He managed the business, with which he combined a newsagent's shop, until three weeks ago. His second wife died in 1942, and he leaves a daughter by the first marriage. He was a member of St Catherine's Spiritualist Church. The funeral took place on Thursday at Ryde Cemetery. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. E. N. BUTLER (son-in-law and daughter), Mr. E. EDWARDS (son-in-law), and Mr. and Mrs. W. SAUNDERS (brother-in-law and sister-in-law). Messrs. WHEELER Bros made the arrangements.
