

**DEATH OF MRS. E.SAUNDERS –**

Mrs. **Edea SAUNDERS** died on Tuesday at 31 Green-street at the age of 68. A native of Weymouth she came to the Island in 1913 and in 1915 married Mr. Alfred E.SAUNDERS, a member of a well-known Haylands family. Mr. and Mrs. SAUNDERS left the Island for a number of years but returned in 1943 to live at 69 Monkton-street. Owing to Mrs. SAUNDERS illness they moved to 31 Green-street, the home of Mr. SAUNDERS' sister, who nursed her throughout a long illness. Mrs. SAUNDERS was a member of the Congregational Women's Guild. She is survived by her husband, three sons and three daughters. The funeral service at the Congregational Church on Thursday was conducted by the Rev. C.HANNAM.
