OBITUARY –

The funeral took place at Holy Trinity Church on Thursday of Mrs. **Lucy Ada BANNISTER**, second daughter of the late C. COOPER, builder, and one of a family of thirteen, of 23 Trinity-street, Ryde. The Vicar (the Rev. D. FORD) officiated. Her death occurred the previous Sunday at St. Mary's Hospital, where she had been a patient since June.

Mrs BANNISTER, who was 78, was a native of the town, and was employed for some years as a dressmaker by Messrs. FOWLER & Co., Union-street. Upon her marriage in 1925 she joined her husband at Brading, where he was caretaker of the old Conservative Club, and shared these duties with him until 1939, when they returned to their former home in Ryde. About five years ago her health began to deteriorate.

Family mourners attending the service were Mr. E. BANNISTER (husband), Mrs. M. SPRAGG and Mrs. F. HAYLES (sisters), Mr. and Mrs. T. EMMETT, Mr. and Mrs. H. P. DAY, and Mr. and Mrs. H. BANNISTER (brothers-in-law and sisters), Mrs. P. BUCKETT and Mrs. J. DELICATE (sisters-in-law), Mrs. R. SMEE, Miss E. C. COOPER (nieces) also representing Mr. C. BANNISTER (brother-in-law), Mr. A. COOPER and Mr. H. COOPER (brothers), Miss. F. COOPER, Mrs. G. HAWKINS and Mrs. G. TALBOT (sisters) were unable to be present. Interment took place in the family grave at Ryde Cemetery.
