COACH PROPRIETOR'S WIFE DIES – MRS. **B. M. PAUL**

An active local business woman until her retirement two years ago, Mrs. **Blanche Mildred PAUL**, of 58 Park-road, Ryde, died at the Royal I.W. County Hospital on Sunday. She was 70.

Mrs. PAUL was a native of Ryde and had lived here all her life. After the First World War she and her husband, Mr. Harry PAUL, who survives her, took over the motor coach business which was started by Mr. PAULs' father as a haulage contractor's, then using coaches and horses. Between them, Mr. and Mrs. PAUL built up the business to its present proportions. They had been married for 51 years, and Mrs. PAUL had been in poor health since October. She entered hospital about two weeks ago.

The funeral takes place today (Thursday) at Holy Trinity Church, Ryde.
