### **FUNERAL OF BRIGADIER-GENERAL G. H. TURNER**

The funeral took place at the Parish Church on Tuesday October 29<sup>th</sup>, of Brigadier-General **George Harvey TURNER**, who passed away somewhat suddenly at the age of 68 years. Deceased was a son of Dr. W. F. J. TURNER, a popular medical man of the borough, who resided for many years at Vernon House and the Wearde, Barfield, and who passed away in 1894. Deceased was an officer in the Indian Army.

There was a short service at the Parish Church conducted by the Rev. A. TOMSETT. The chief mourners were the widow, her two daughters, Mr. and Mrs. Wilton TURNER (brother and sister-in-law), and a nephew.
