### **DEATH CAPT. A.T.CARTER.**

The Late Capt. **A.T. CARTER**, R.N. ---The funeral of this officer took place at the Cemetery on Saturday afternoon. Deceased joined the Royal Navy as a Naval cadet in 1868. In 1875 he became a sub-lieutenant and in 1879 a lieutenant. Captain CARTER noted as lieutenant of the Condor at the bombardment of Alexandria, 1882, and during the Egyptian war. He received the Egyptian medal, the Alexandria clasp, and the Khedive's bronze star. He was lieutenant and executive officer of the Sphinx during the naval and military operations in the Eastern Soudan, 1884-85, being mentioned in the despatches and receiving the Saukin, 1885, the Tofrek clasps. As first lieutenant on the same ship he served during the Burma Annexation war of 1885-86, Captain CARTER was given the command of the Indian Marine ship Tigris, and served with the Naval Brigade until the beginning of 1886. He received the commander in 1890 and Captain in 1896. The first part of the service was chorally rendered at All Saints' Church, the Revs, J. SHEARME and W. HAMILTON officiating. The hymns "Abide with me" and "On the resurrection morning" were sung.

The mourners were Mrs. CARTER (widow), the Rev. CANON and Mrs. CARTER, ( father and mother), the Rev. W. CARTER and Miss CARTER, Mrs. RAWSON, Mr. RAWSON, and Mr. C.RAWSON. The coffin was of polished oak with brass mountings and was covered with a Union Jack

as a pall. Twelve sailors from H.M.S. Excellent acted as bearers. The inscription on the coffin was ; “ Archibald Thomas CARTER died November 30<sup>th</sup>, 1899, aged 45 years.” The grave was lined with ivy. Amongst those present were Capt. HANCOCK, Mr. E.CARTER, J.P., the Rev. W.H.E. WELBY, Mr. George FARDELL, and Mr. T.F. and Mrs. PERROTT.

Mrs. DICKSON PEWILL, Mrs. and Miss CARTER, “Aunt Eva and Evelyn,” Miss Jane BARTER, and Mr. and Mrs. RATCLIFFE.
