**FUNERAL OF MRS. J. R. SLADE**

On Saturday morning the funeral service according to the rights of the Roman Catholic Church, were performed with great solemnity over the grave of **Lucia Amelia Aurora Vicenta**, the deceased wife of Mr. John Ramsey SLADE, eldest son of the late General SLADE. The deceased lady, we regret to say, died at the early age of 19 years, having been married about twelve months. She was of Spanish extract, and her extraordinary amiability won for her the high esteem of all who had the pleasure of knowing her. She died on Monday the 21<sup>st</sup> inst., and her remains were conveyed to St. Marie's Church on Friday, the Dirge being sung in the evening. On the following day the Requiem Mass was sung at 9 o'clock, and at each of these services there was a numerous congregation. At about 10 o'clock on Saturday morning the body was removed to the Cemetery and deposited within a few yards of the resting place of the gallant General, whose name she adopted.
