DEATH OF SIR JOHN MACGREGOR, M.D., K.C.B.

In our obituary today is announced the death of Sir John MACGREGOR, who expired on Saturday last at Corstorphine Lodge, Ryde. The deceased (who assumed the name of MACGREGOR in 1863), was the 2nd son of Mr. Duncan M'ANDREW, and was born at Perth in 1792. Having studied for some time at the University of Edinburgh in 1809 he entered the Medical department of the Army, and saw considerable service. In 1856 he received the appointment of Inspector-General of Hospitals and three years later in 1859 was appointed one of the honorary physicians of Her Majesty, in the same year being created a Knight Commander of the Order of the Bath.
