FUNERAL OF MR. W. HAMMOND RIDDETT, J.P., AT RYDE.

Amidst manifestation of deepest regret and sympathy the funeral of Mr. William Hammond RIDDETT, J.P., who died at Matlock on August 12th, took place at Ryde on Saturday. The first portion of the service was held at All Saints' Parish Church, of which the deceased was a former churchwarden. The Vicar (the Rev. Hugh LE FLEMING) officiated, assisted by the Rev. C.L. BLAKE. The service was quite plain. The lesson was read by the Rev. C.L. BLAKE and the hymn "Let the saints on earth in concert sing" was sung.
