### OBITUARY

The death took place at 19 Nelson-street, on Thursday week of Mrs. **Emma FOWLES**, widow of Mr. Arthur Wellington FOWLES, who was a well-known marine artist in the town nearly half a century ago and whose works are still to be seen in the Town-halls here and at Newport, Shanklin, and Southampton. Deceased, who was 84 years of age and was better known to the older residents, had been a widow for nearly 40 years, living quietly with her devoted daughter.

The funeral took place on Monday, the first part of the service being conducted at Holy Trinity Church by the Vicar (the Rev. N.H. STUBBS), The interment was at the Cemetery and the mourners were Miss Maud FOWLES (daughter), Mr. A. FENNINGS, of Cowes, and Mrs. LOWE, Mr. Ernest FOWLES, the well-known musical adjudicator, who was one of the judges at the recent Musical Festival, was a distant relative of deceased.
