DEATH OF MR. H. RYMER

We regret to announce the death of Mr. **Harry RYMER**, at the age of 32, third son of Mrs. RYMER, of St. John's Wood-road, who passed away on Friday after a short illness. The funeral took place on Tuesday at the Ryde Cemetery. The mourners were Mrs. RYMER (mother), Walter and Arthur RYMER (brothers), and Miss RYMER (sister). There were a number of beautiful floral tributes. The late Harry RYMER was formerly in the 1st Hampshire Regt., and had the Mons Ribbon. He had seen service in Salonica and France and was wounded and invalided out of the Army.
