## DIED IN HOSPITAL AFTER A FALL – Mrs. L.M. VERGINE

The Island Coroner, Mr. J. V. BULLIN recorded a verdict of accidental death at an inquest held at the Town Hall on Thursday on Mrs. **Louise M. VERGINE**, aged 74, of 31 Adelaide-place, Ryde, who died on February 24<sup>th</sup> at the Royal I.W. County Hospital.

Evidence was given by the deceased's son-in-law, Mr. R. H. BAGWELL, headmaster of Ryde County Secondary School, who said that Mrs. VERGINE fell down in her home late on the night of January 16. Her husband, who is partially deaf, was in bed. Without his hearing aid he was unaware of his wife's accident.

Mrs. VERGINE managed to get to a chair where she remained till her husband came down at 3 a.m. She stayed in the chair until 1 p.m. when she was taken to hospital. A successful operation for fracture of the left femur was performed on January 20.

Dr. P. D. SWINSTEAD said the cause of death was hypostatic pneumonia and the fractured left femur was a contributive cause.
