THE LATE CHARLES BRETT, ESQ.

During the week a handsome tomb (by ELLERY) has been erected in the Cemetery over the remains of the above highly-esteemed and deeply lamented gentleman. It is of Portland stone, nicely carved, with four polished granite columns, being enclosed by a curb and neat iron railing, and bearing the following inscription: "Sacred to the memory of Charles BRETT, Esq., J.P., of The Wood, St. John's Park, Ryde, who entered into his rest Dec. 26, 1877, aged 71 years."
