### DEATH OF A CATHOLIC PRIEST

Our obituary records the death of the Rev. **Joseph SILVEIRA**, which took place at Parnham Cottage, Swanmore-road on Friday last, at the age of 82 years. The deceased was a native of Lisbon but had resided in England from an early age. He was educated at St. Edmund's College, Herts; was a good organist and preacher and for many years a hardworking priest in London and other places. He was well known and highly respected in this town, having resided amongst us for 23 years. On Thursday morning his remains were conveyed to St. Mary's Church, in which the deceased had often officiated, where a solemn Dirge and High Mass took place, a number of the clergy being present, at the conclusion of which the body was removed to the Catholic portion of the Cemetery where it was interred under the shadow of the beautiful cemetery cross which was erected by the late Rev. J. TELFORD. The service was performed by the Rev. J. B. CAHILL. The outer coffin was of polished oak, with a handsome brass cross at the head and foot, and a brass plate with the following inscription:

REV. JOSEPH SILVEIRA  
Died 27<sup>th</sup> Oct., 1876,  
In the 58<sup>th</sup> year of his priesthood,  
Aged 82 years.
