DEATH OF MISS WISE

A greatly respected resident passed away on Monday in the person of Miss **Marianne Jackson WISE**, of Bembridge House, George-street. Born at Carisbrooke on the 20th of June, 1821, the deceased lady had reached the great age of 93 years. She remembered Ryde as a fishing village, and her reminiscences of the olden times were of a very vivid and entertaining character. Miss WISE's father gave the site on which Bembridge Church stands, and there is a pew in the building belonging to the WISE family. The deceased took a great interest in parochial matters. The funeral was on Wednesday, the first part of the service being held at the Parish Church, the Vicar (the Rev. Hugh Le FLEMING, M.A.) officiating.
