MR. M. TREDWELL

A steward at the York Hotel since 1940, Mr. **Martin TREDWELL**, of 13 St. John's Wood-road, died on Friday at the Royal I.W. County Hospital after a short illness. He was 82. Born in Ryde, Mr. TREDWELL served as a steward with the Cunard Company and the P. & O.-Orient Line for most
